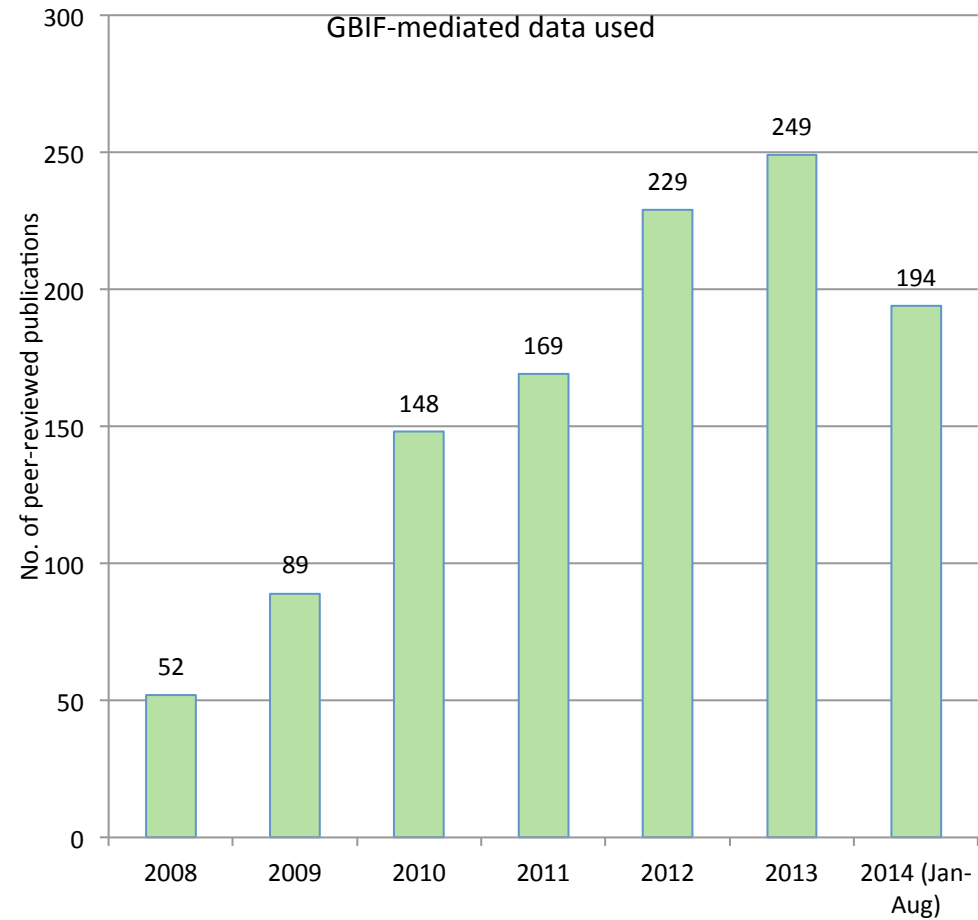

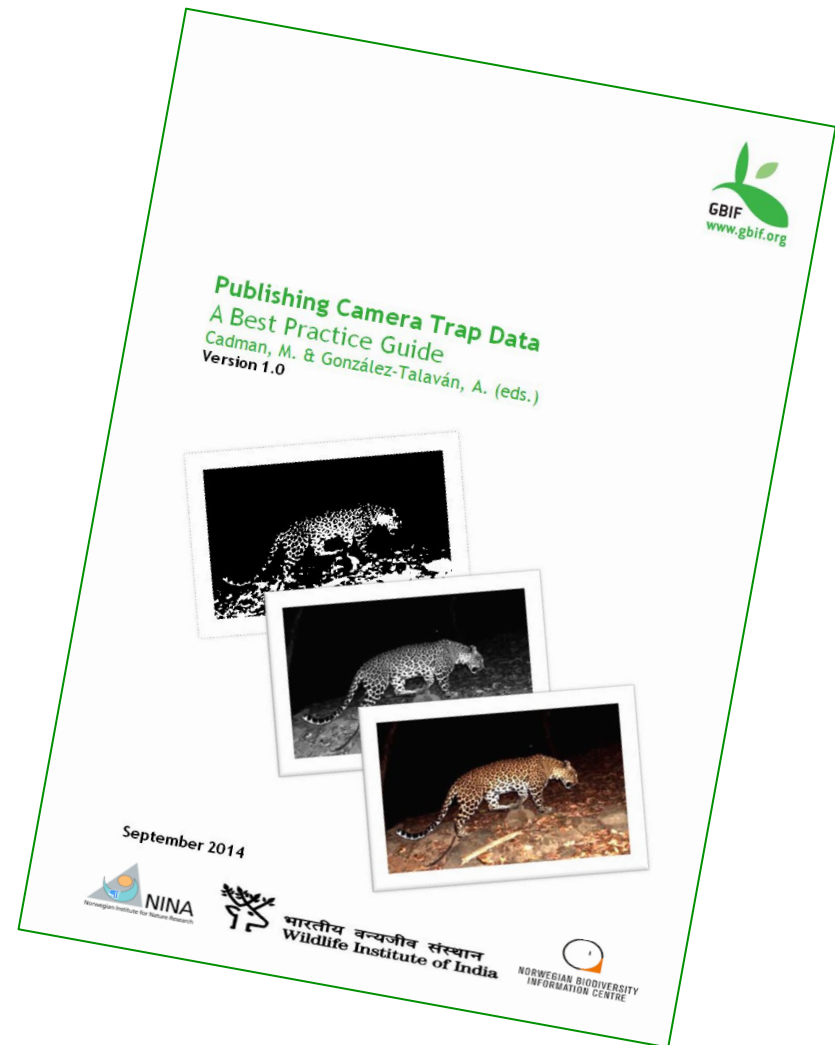

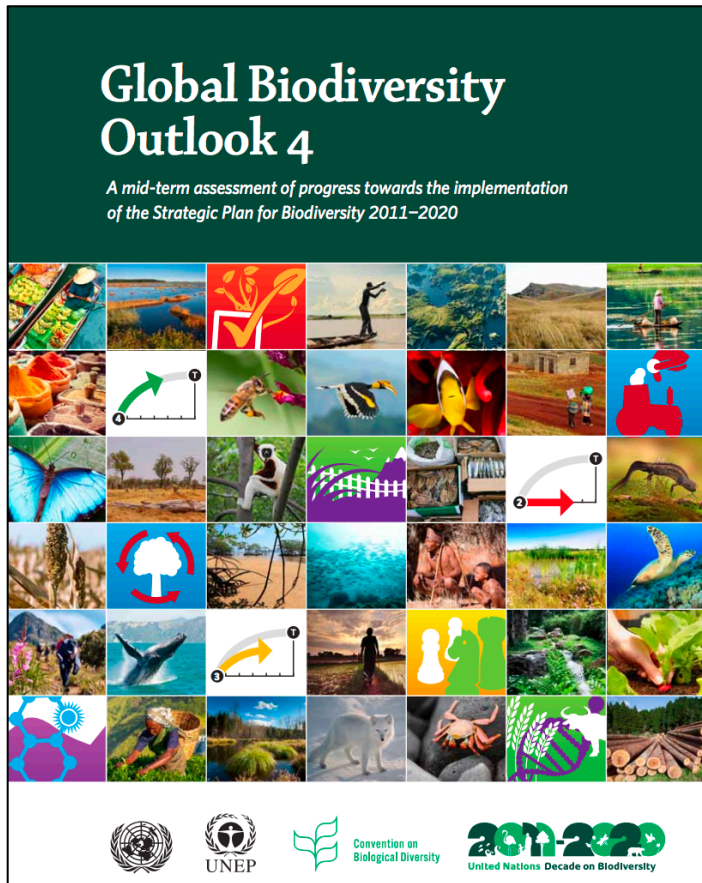


GBIF IMPACTS: SUPPORTING AICHI TARGETS
